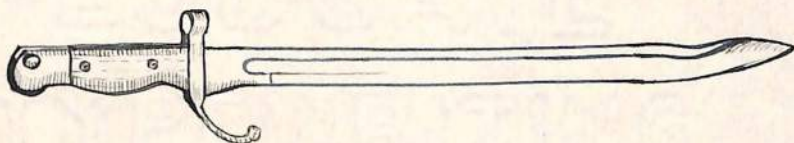

1870-75.

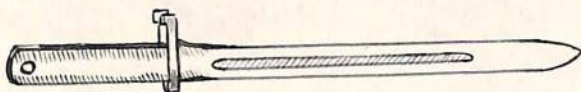


Steel, wood backed hilt.

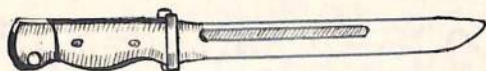
TURKISH BAYONET. 1905

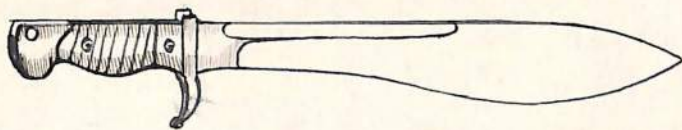


Wood and steel hilt, with

GERMAN BAYONET "WEBEL"

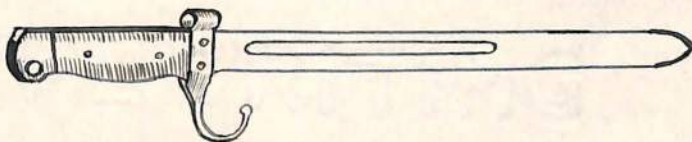

GERMAN. BAYONET. "MAUSER.

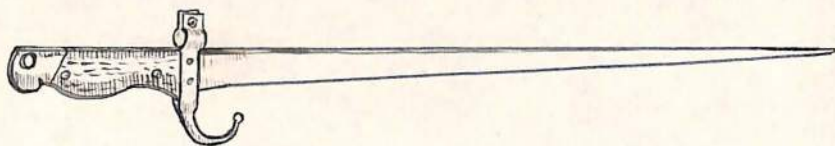

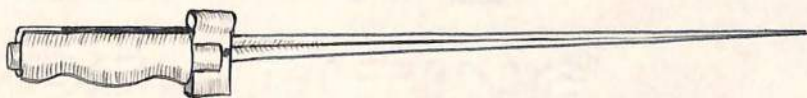
Steel hilt with wood sides and

FRENCH BAYONET.

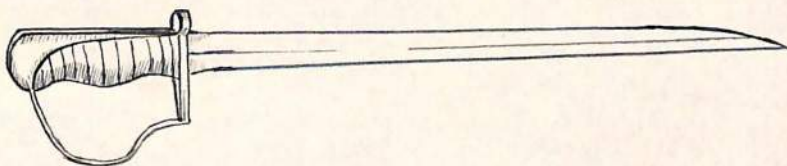
1844. Infantry Rifle.

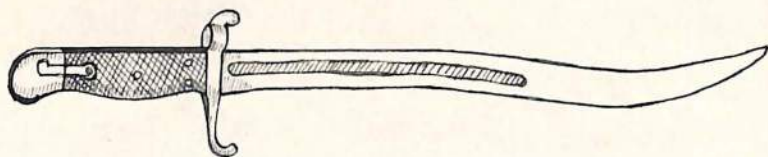
English Infantry Sword Bayonet.

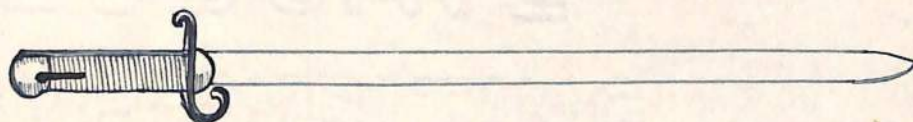
ENGLISH BAYONET. "LEE ENFIELD" 1907.
